Letter from the President

Dear Members and Friends of Elin Pelin Foundation:

I'm delighted to report that 2017 was another year of triumph for Elin Pelin Foundation!

It is my belief, that at time of darkness is when true humanity shines and people selflessly reach out to help one another. Hurricane Harvey affected several families within the Bulgarian-American Community in Houston. Elin Pelin Foundation organized volunteer help and created a Hurricane Harvey Relief (HHR) Fund where \$7000 were raised and then distributed between the families affected by Hurricane Harvey. In effort to encourage people's generosity, Elin Pelin Foundation combined two other events The Social Mixer in the Fall 2017 and a theatrical play "Do Not Bet on The Brits" performed by DT "K. Velichkov" Pazardjik. The actors generously donated their fees to the HHR Fund. Held twice a year the Social Mixer is an event where dozens of our members and friends can share business stories, while enjoying fine wine and appetizers, and meeting new people. I am proud of the Bulgarian-American Society in Houston! We proved that we have unity and nobility! I praise each volunteer, each donor, every person who reached out and asked, "How can I help?" You have my deepest appreciation!

Thanks to volunteers, a concert was organized on a very short notice. Vasko the Patch, a singer who is a symbol love, peace, freedom and Bulgaria's first days as democratic country, was on a tour in US. He adjusted his schedule and made a stop in Houston to perform for his Bulgarian and American fans. His Blues, Rock'n'Roll and country tunes were soothing to souls after so much stress caused by Hurricane Harvey.

For a second consecutive year our Elin Pelin Bulgarian School resided at the historic Dow School building, home of MECA (Multi-cultural Education and Counseling through the Arts – a community-based nonprofit organization). Our school's sixth consecutive school-year was successful with over 20 enrolled students, divided into five separate classes. With the help of volunteers Summer Camp "Smehuranci" 2017 prepared a theatrical play "Kose Bose". Students rehearsed throughout the summer and prepared the decors. At the beginning of the school-year we the parents were thrilled by their children's performance.

Elin Pelin Foundation hosted Bulgarika's concert in November 2017. The talented folk musicians sang and played, while people danced traditional Bulgarian group dances. The Houston International Folk Dancers and our friends the dancers of Bulgarian Rose were among the guests.

This school year we received numerous gifts from Bulgaria - History and Children's books and Disk with patriotic songs. Words cannot express my gratitude for those kind gifts!







Unaudited Financial Data Summary for 2016-2017


