# **Letter from the President**

Dear Members and Friends of Elin Pelin Foundation:

I am delighted to report that the past year has been successful for Elin Pelin Foundation despite the temporary cancellations of social and cultural events.

There were no changes to The Board in 2020. Following Harris County's "Stay Home, Work Safe Order" the work of the foundation was mostly related to its main project – the First Bulgarian School in Houston Elin Pelin. Our newly implemented hybrid form of teaching attracted new students residing not only in the Houston greater area but also in Central and South Texas. Enrollment reached unprecedented numbers and as a direct result, the faculty grew with three teachers from San Antonio joining the team. The increased number of teachers required us to switch most teachers from contractor status to W-2 employees. That resulted an increase in expenses, but thanks to our main patrons, Elin Pelin Foundation did not have to apply for Paycheck Protection Program. The Bulgarian Ministry of Education and Science funded the school with more than \$23,000. PDT Partners issued a grant to Elin Pelin Foundation in the amount of \$5,000. Reliant, an NRG Company with their many charity programs granted the Foundation a total of \$3,000. At the last day of school more than 90 people attended the Outdoor Celebration, which shows that the schoolyear 2020-2021 was a complete success and the upcoming 2021-2022 is even more promising.

Elin Pelin Foundation was created in 2012 with the idea to represent and support a small Bulgarian School in Houston Texas. Throughout the years our focus has expanded from education-only to supporting the arts and providing the community with cultural enrichment programs and cross-cultural experiences. In 2022 our Foundation will be celebrating its 10<sup>th</sup> year Anniversary. It is my pleasure to announce that the event will be formal and exclusive. To add value to the membership, we will make the event free to members of Elin Pelin Foundation. We hope you will encourage your relatives and friends to join the foundation and attend this special event.

I would like to invite all members to consider becoming part of The Board or Staff of Elin Pelin Foundation. The Board's main tasks are to search and/or provide funds and lead projects. A director's position is a oneyear commitment with some very reasonable requirements and expectations. Any idea which benefits the community could be turned into reality if you are willing to dedicate your time and efforts. Elin Pelin Foundation can provide you with a team to split the workload and to help find sponsors. The Board of directors is elected anew by the foundation members on an annual basis. A Staff position is a lengthier commitment, but the hiring process is done by The Board members – not through elections. If interested in applying, please talk to any representative of The Foundation. Anyone from our team would be happy to answer your questions and help you apply. In conclusion, I respectfully thank every single one of the supporters of Elin Pelin Foundation's cause! Whether it was a Birthday Fundraiser initiative, a monthly donation of \$25 through PayPal, a one-time donation of \$100 or \$500, an employee gift match of \$1,000, or the unexpected grant of \$5,000 on behalf of Mr. Nikola Chonkov, those surprising gifts are proof that Elin Pelin Foundation will be here tomorrow, and it will continue to support the education, culture, and arts. ### Summer School – Virtual Instruction – June & July 2020

Elin Pelin School is organized Virtual Summer Classes for two different age groups in June and July, using Zoom classroom and Ucha.se resources. The Summer School allowed current and future students to refresh their

knowledge of Bulgarian while participating in fun and creative activities. The curriculum included children's songs, games, virtual field trips, crafts, fairytales, but the best feature were the special guests – a famous singer, a sports coach, a police officer, and a constable visited the classes and talked to students about their jobs, duties, and experience.

### School Year 2020 – 2021 over 40 Enrolled Students

On the 12th of September the First Bulgarian School in Houston Elin Pelin opened its doors for hybrid classes at two locations and Zoom classrooms. Since 2016 our school's main location is at the historic Dow School building, home of MECA (Multi-cultural Education and Counseling through the Arts – a community-based nonprofit organization).

The spacious building of Hosanna Lutheran Church with two adjoining kindergarten rooms and a shaded playground is a great fit for our students and is our current secondary location in the North. Following CDC guidelines, sanitary stations were available at both locations.



After the popular 2020 Summer School, there was a record number of enrolled students of all ages; over 40 students were signed up in the beginning of 2020-2021 school year. Throughout the year that number increased. Three teachers from San Antonio, TX officially joined the Elin Pelin School faculty, and held remote lessons every week. The school's 9th consecutive schoolyear was successful with the number of enrolled students exceeding anyone's expectations.




