Letter from the President

Dear Members and Friends of Elin Pelin Foundation:

As some of you know, after the passing of Mrs. Dimitria Dzarbova, Mrs. Rayna Levakova stepped in as the new principal of the First Bulgarian School in Houston Elin Pelin. Under Mrs. Levakova's leadership, the school grew and is now not only online, but also in three cities with four physical locations. We have more than eighty registered students for 2022-2023. The school year was a complete success in every branch.

Having said that, Elin Pelin Foundation had a somewhat unusual year, where our expenses exceeded the contributions. That is not surprising to us since the school grew as much as it did in such a short period of time. Additionally, it has never been a secret that the school as a project cannot survive only by the subsidies and tuition alone. We need all the financial support we can get; hence more social events and fundraisers should be organized to raise the needed funds. Our reserve contribution from past years was there to fill the gap, but today I plead to all members to help us find more corporate donations which would be a great aid when it comes to paying for building, school supplies or other school expenses.

This past year we celebrated our 10th year Anniversary in a formal manner and at this black-tie event I announced the launch of an Annual Scholarship of \$1000 in honor of the memory of Dimitria Dzarbova. While this project is still in progress, I will continue to do everything in my power to raise more funds and ensure its succession for the next 10 years. As you see, help is needed not only when we talk about the success of the Bulgarian school, but also for any charitable cause that is dear to your heart.

I will end my address with the usual invitation to all members to consider becoming part of The Board or an Officer of Elin Pelin Foundation. The Board's main tasks are to search and/or provide funds and lead projects. A director's position is a one-year commitment with some very reasonable requirements and expectations. The Board of directors is elected anew by the foundation members on an annual basis. An officer position would be for the purpose of helping actively in a particular project. If interested in

School Year 2022 – 2023 86 Total Enrolled Students in Three Locations

Under Mrs. Rayna Levakova's leadership the foundation now represents three branches of Elin Pelin School in three cities with a total of four physical locations.

The Bulgarian Teachers in Austin joined Elin Pelin Foundation and established an Austin Branch of Bulgarian School Elin Pelin. We are very happy to be working with such an enthusiastic faculty. We hope the parents from Austin will recognize the efforts all of us in the foundation and school put into improving the quality of instruction and will want to help us in the future by finding more donors or themselves sponsoring future school and foundation related events.

The quick progress of Austin branch and the dedicated online instruction, and the in-person Folk Dance classes attracted parents from San Antonio to request opening a San Antonio in-person branch. With the help of Mrs. Svetlana Markova, Elin Pelin Foundation Received a grant of \$2000 which greatly helped in the process of renting a temporary location for the FBS Elin Pelin San Antonio. We are happy to announce that the second semester included in-person lessons for the San Antonio population. We are currently in the process of renting a more permanent space for the needs of our San Antonio branch.

150 Years since the hanging of Vasil Levski – February 2023

On 19 February Bulgarians pay homage to Vasil Levski. The Apostle of Freedom was hanged on 18 February 1873 in Sofia after he was betrayed and condemned to death by an Ottoman court of justice. Levski created a powerful clandestine revolutionary network aimed to plan and carry out an uprising to gain Bulgaria's independence from the Ottoman Empire. He is Bulgaria's most popular national hero, a legend for his valor, agility and wisdom. To commemorate the great hero, our sixth and seventh grade students created a video telling the story of Vasil Levski.





Unaudited Financial Data Summary for 2022-2023


