Letter from the President

Dear Members and Friends of Elin Pelin Foundation:

Every year the act of me going over everything we've accomplished inadvertently fills my heart with pride and joy. I also feel gratitude for all those individuals who gave from their time or finances to a cause which benefits not only all members and students but also extends to friends and neighbors. It is my honor to recognize several individuals.

Hristina Pavlina (*see picture*) is stepping down from the board of directors. After several years of dedicated service, she tried to step down last year, but in our time of need (December 2024) she agreed to substitute for Mrs. Evans. Ina has been an invaluable asset to the Foundation, especially with her help with the School Report to the Ministry of Education. Ina will remain a Legacy member and a trusted advisor, and we will continue to seek her guidance on questions concerning the foundation. Also, special thanks to Ina's husband Mr. Venelin Pavlin who deserves our gratitude and apologies for taking so much of Ina's time. We are very grateful for your patience! We wish the whole Pavlin family all the best in the years to come!

I would like to welcome to the company three ladies, Mrs. Gergana Patetta and Mrs. Gabriela Mladenova (see picture - in red t-shirt), and Mariana Nencheva (on right). They are current officers and parents of students of the Bulgarian school in Houston. Mrs. Patteta and Mrs. Mladenova joined us at a crucial time, when we needed a thorough review of the school and the company's financial situation. Mrs. Mariana Nencheva joined Elin Pelin Foundation as a Parent-Teacher Communication Officer. Her help is also very much appreciated by the whole team.

I must say a few words about the financial difficulty of the school. In 2022 Elin Pelin school grew significantly with opening a branch in Austin. This sudden growth spur took us to a different level as a non-profit. The unaudited annual financial report was not sufficient and specific enough to analyze (and help us prevent) the deficit. In 2023-24 with fundraisers and more, we were able to offset the great expense we had with the school, but we had to learn how to budget. Additionally, in 2024 our greatest



patrons could not donate or made a much smaller donation than previous years. That led to the logical conclusion that a major financial audit is needed, so we can establish what needs to be changed and what our future financial goals should be. As soon as we felt the disbalance between inflow and outflow, Mrs. Svetlana Markova – who is currently on the Board of directors, created our

first budget. In the beginning of 2024-25 school year Mrs. Gabriela Mladenova took on the task of analyzing last year's school earnings and spendings and she created our current budget. Mrs. Gergana Patetta (see picture on left) organized the most successful fundraiser for this school year. Additionally, Mrs. Patetta along with Mrs. Rayna Levakova and several other anonymous donors who work at USAA became our biggest contributors through American Online Giving Foundation/Benevity program.

Another parent who deserves recognition is Mr. Pavel Vasilev who made a significant donation which was matched by his place of employment. Hopefully all parents from the Bulgarian school will follow his example and check with their companies they gift match to non-profits. In the forms of Culture and Art, Elin Pelin Foundation is bringing value to the entire Bulgarian American community of Texas. Any help would be very much appreciated!

On behalf of the whole team I can say we are thrilled to see organizational growth and financial stability this year.


Bulgarian Film at Houston International Film Festival – The Therapy – April 2025



Unaudited Financial Data Summary for 2024-2025


